Col. Bodisch ask that I write and inform you that the DVD on floods will be used at the two annual training summer camps involving the Texas State Guard during the months of July and August 2006 and will be viewed by over 1,600 soldiers of the TXSG for training purposes. It will also be used throughout the training year as a refresher and to train new soldiers coming into the TXSG.

As a point of information the Texas State Guard is an all volunteer organization that is under the command of the Governor and can and is called out on State Active Duty during various disasters. When the Shuttle blew up there were TXSG soldiers in East Texas searching for parts, when the hurricanes Katrina and Rita destroyed La. and the coast of Texas and over 177,000 Displaced Neighbors were moved to Texas over 1,600 TXSG soldiers ran numerous shelters in conjunction with the Red Cross. Our mission is Civil Affairs and responding during disasters is what we do. Your DVD and material like it are valuable training tools for us. Thank you for allowing us to use it.
